

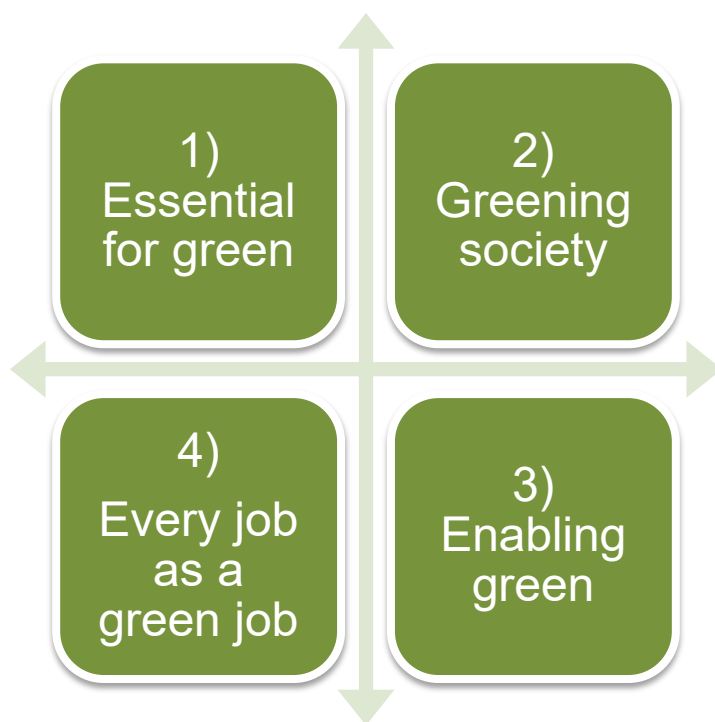
Green, Sustainable & Socially Responsible Careers

What is a green job?

All jobs can be classed as green as every job will have some impact on the environment. Green jobs are not just for Environmental Management, Science or Geography graduates!

“Green jobs will not be niche. We anticipate that sustainability and climate change will touch every career.” *Department for Education, UK Government (2022)*

Types of green jobs



1) Essential for green jobs – Net zero and nature emergency jobs

Jobs that support decarbonisation and nature-based solutions to preserve or restore the environment and planet. Example careers include:

- Agriculture and land use
- Biodiversity conservation
- Circular waste and resource management
- Construction
- Energy
- Engineering
- Environment and sustainability management
- Manufacturing
- Transport

2) Greening society jobs – Behaviour and system change jobs

Creating social and systemic change. Example careers include:

- Education and training
- Environmental and social entrepreneurship
- Environmental law
- Data science, programming and development
- Green finance
- Green hospitality and tourism
- Social impact/mobility/values
- Sustainability consultancy/ engagement/ management

3) Enabling green jobs – Jobs to make green organisations run smoothly

Non-green jobs supporting green organisations with your skills. Example careers include:

- Accountancy and finance
- Administration
- Customer Relations
- Human Resources
- ICT
- Logistics
- Management
- Marketing and Communications

4) Every job as a green job – Making your job greener

Improving the environmental impact of jobs that are not directly connected to environmental issues. Example careers include:

- Healthcare
- Hospitality
- ICT
- Teaching
